

CHAOS Rock the Universe Trip Info

September 5-7, 2008

This will be an awesome opportunity for our Middle school group! It will be an opportunity for some to hear their favorite Christian bands and for others to be introduced to Christian music at a whole new level! Everyone will also have an opportunity to get to know each other and develop new friendships.

We will meet at Bethel at 1:30pm. We plan to depart at 2:00pm so please be on time. This may mean that some of you will have to get out of school early but we want you to get the most out of this trip and if we leave any later we won't arrive in Orlando until after 7:00pm.

Friday Night

We will first stop at the home we rented for a QUICK drop off of our belongings and room assignments. We will be renting a home where everyone will stay together as a group. Then we'll head over to **Universal Orlando** for a night of concerts and rides. There will be one concert/speaker that you are required to see as a group, that means everyone on the trip will attend at least 1 concert together. This is TBD on Friday. During the night Middle School students must be with a chaperone. At 1:00am we will all meet up at the Universal Globe and head back to our rented house.

Saturday

We will get up and hang out at the house. We will have a morning devotional, so bring your Bibles. You will have breakfast and lunch at the house. Around 3:00 we'll head out to **Universal for Rock the Universe**. There will be one concert/speaker that you are required to see as a group, that means everyone on the trip will attend at least 1 concert together. This is TBD on Saturday. Same rules apply as far as chaperones are concerned. We will meet up at the Universal Globe at 1:00 am again.

Sunday

We will eat breakfast, clean up the home and **attend a worship service** in the area. We will be stopping for a fast food lunch. We should be home around 5:00 but will have students call parents when we are 1 hour out.

This is an exciting trip where you can hear some new Christian music, and make new friends!

Cost:

We will not know until after our 2 fundraisers, how much the trip will cost the students. We are doing everything possible to keep the costs minimal. Right now we are estimating the cost per person to be about \$150 ea. (Don't panic, this is before the fundraising!) Parents should be prepared to pay \$50 for each child.
